- ✓ No long forms / major discipline reports from 9/18/17 to the date of the dance.

The dance will be a way to recognize the sixth grade students' academic and behavioral achievements, led by the Beta Club. The Beta Club is planning and hosting the event. The event costs \$5 to attend, by invitation only, and will feature a fun theme and DJ.

Concessions will be sold and parents are welcome to attend. Students will pay their admission costs at the dance.

Other sixth grade special events planned include a Spring Dance, End of School Year Picnic, and Promotion Ceremony. Additional information will be made available at a later date, but similar attendance criteria will apply.
