We use the Ready GEN curriculum for first grade ELA. This time also consists of writing, language, phonics, and independent reading.

In math, we use the Eureka curriculum. We will cover number bonds, addition and subtraction, word problems, shapes, time, and many more topics!

# HOMework

**Newsletters:** Our newsletter can best be implemented as a study guide. It tells you our main focuses in each subject for the week, as well as what will be tested. The ELA vocabulary words and decodable words are all listed on the newsletter.

**Sight words:** A list of 25 sight words is sent home for the students to study and practice reading. Once your child has mastered the list, sign it so I know they are ready to test. If the student passes the list, they move to the next 25!

**Reading:** Weekly reading stories with aligned comprehension questions are sent home on Mondays. The students have the entire week to complete the passages.

**Math:** Weekly math pages are sent home on Mondays. The students have the entire week to complete the math homework.

**Social Living:** I do not send social living homework home, but we do complete multiple activities in class throughout the week that can be reviewed.

# ATTENDANCE!

- **If your child is absent for any reason, a note from you or from a doctor must be presented and checked by the office so that the absence can be excused.**

# UNIFORMS!

## SHIRTS

- Shirts must be a red or white polo style with collar and buttons, not a T-shirt.
- The only acceptable logo on the shirt is the Superstar. No other logos, emblems, or monograms allowed.
- Spirit shirts can be purchased for \$10 and can be worn any day of the week.

## BOTTOMS

- Bottoms must be navy blue. (shorts, pants, skorts, skirts, capris, etc. )
- Leggings or jeggings or tight-fitting pants can only be worn under skirts or shorts

## **STUDENT ELECTRONIC COMMUNICATION WIRELESS DEVICES POLICY**

- “Wireless devices” includes, but is not limited to, cellular phones (whether analog or digital), camera phones, beepers, pagers, text messaging devices and PDA’s that are used as telecommunication devices or to transmit text messages, as well as any other wireless electronic telecommunication devices.
